AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 190.5
ADOPTED MAY 21, 1992, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE
NO. 190 ADOPTED JULY 17, 1980, ESTABLISHING
RATES AND CHARGES FOR SEWER DISPOSAL SERVICE
BY THE OLIVEHURST PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Directors of the Olivehurst Public Utility District, as follows:

Ordinance No. 190.5, adopted May 21, 1992, is hereby rescinded, and Ordinance No. 190, an Ordinance establishing rates and charges for sewer disposal service, is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE I. SEWER SERVICE CHARGES

1. <u>Rate Schedule</u>. Sewer service charges are hereby prescribed as follows:

2. Plumbing units shall be computed by 6 for a toilet or slop
sink with a 3-inch diameter or less outlet; 2 for a sink, bath tub,
shower, laundry tray or floor drain; and 1 for a lavatory or wash

basin.

- 3. When more than one use as described under this Ordinance is conducted in the same premises or upon the same Assessor's Parcel, a separate monthly charge as provided under this Ordinance shall be paid for each such use.
 - 4. This Ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 1994.
- 5. This Ordinance shall be immediately posted at three public places within the District as provided by the Public Utility Code, Section 16075.
