

ORDINANCE NO. 2

ELECTING THAT DUTIES OF TREASURER BE PERFORMED BY THE COUNTY TREASURER.

OLIVEHURST PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Directors of Olivehurst Public Utility District, as follows:

1. The duties of Treasurer of this District shall be performed by the County Treasurer of Yuba County, California. Said duties shall be those provided by law for said office, and no additional bond shall be required from said Treasurer, other than his official bond as County Treasurer, and which shall include ex-officio his duties for this District.

2. The income and revenue paid to said District shall be kept in a fund to be entitled OLIVEHURST PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT GENERAL FUND, excepting funds to pay the principal and interest of any bonds of the District, which shall be entitled OLIVEHURST PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT INTEREST AND REDEMPTION FUND, SERIES _____, and excepting funds raised for the acquisition and construction of an improvement, which shall be entitled OLIVEHURST PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT CONSTRUCTION FUND NO. _____, and excepting such other funds as are provided by law or hereafter established by the District.

3. All claims properly allowed by the Board of Directors of said District shall be paid by warrant on said Treasurer signed by the President and Accountant of said District and audited and allowed by the County Auditor.

4. Warrants drawn on the Treasurer are entitled to preference as to payment out of moneys in the fund applicable to such warrants, according to the order in which they shall be presented to the treasurer.

5. Warrants of the District shall be in the following form:

6. The provisions of law pertaining to counties now or hereafter made and provided, relating to the manner of presenting and paying warrants and settling accounts, as far as they may be applicable, except as herein otherwise provided, shall apply.

7. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be delivered each, the County Treasurer and County Auditor of Yuba County.

8. This Ordinance shall take effect upon the expiration of thirty days after its passage, and shall be posted by the Clerk at three public places in the District at least one week before the expiration of said period.
