WHEREAS, the Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements requires preparation of a Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP) with eleven (11) separate elements; and

WHEREAS, the SSMP Development is required to be recertified every five years by the governing body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Olivehurst Public Utility District approves and recertifies 11 elements of the SSMP according to required recertification guidelines set forth by the State.
