ORDINANCE NO. 186.7

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 186.6
ADOPTED MAY 17, 1994, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE
NO. 186, ADOPTED JULY 17, 1980, AND ESTABLISHING
RATES AND CHARGES FOR WATER SERVICE BY THE
OLIVEHURST PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Directors of the Olivehurst
Public Utility District as follows:

Ordinance No. 186.6, adopted May 17, 1994, is hereby rescinded,
and Ordinance No. 186, adopted July 17, 1980, an Ordinance
establishing rates and charges for water service, is hereby amended
as follows:

ARTICLE I. PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION

1. Monthly Rates. The monthly rates for private fire
protection shall be established by the District at the time
application for service is made. The minimum charge per month shall
be Seventeen Dollars and Forty Cents (\$17.40).

2. Meter Rates. Any consumption recorded on the meter will
be charged for at double the regular service rates except that no
charge will be made for water used to extinguish accidental fires
where such fires have been reported to the duly authorized fire
protection agency.

ARTICLE II. CREDIT

1. Credit. The applicant shall pay the estimated cost of
service in advance or shall be otherwise required to establish
credit. The minimum charge for water shall be Eight Dollars and
Twenty-Five Cents (\$8.25).

ARTICLE III. FLAT RATES

1. Flat Rate Schedule. Rates for unmetered water services are hereby established as follows:

RESIDENTIAL:

- (a) Single family residence and trailers on a lot of 10,000 sq. ft. or less.....\$14.75
- (b) Multi-family residence Each family unit..... 14.75

COMMERCIAL:

- (a) Barber Shops and Beauty Shops..... 14.75
Beauty Shops-combined with Barber Shop..... 25.15
Each additional operator or barber over one each for beauty shop and barber shop..... 4.30
- (b) Clinics, hospitals, convalescent homes or maternity homes:
10 rooms or less..... 37.80
Over 10 rooms, additional per room..... 4.30
- (c) Commercial water-cooled refrigeration in addition to other charges:
5 horsepower and under..... 14.75
Over 5 horsepower..... 25.15
- (d) Garages:
With wash rack..... 33.50
Without wash rack..... 14.75
- (e) Laundries.....Meter only
- (f) Offices, other than herein specified..... 14.75
- (g) Paint shops..... 14.75
- (h) Printing shops..... 14.75
- (i) Roof sprinkler and evaporation cooler without re-circulation pump, each..... 8.40
- (j) Saloons and Beer Parlors..... 16.80
- (k) Service Stations:
Without wash rack..... 18.30
With wash rack..... 37.80
- (l) Swimming Pools, at time of each filling per 100 cu. ft..... 1.60
- (m) All places of business except as herein otherwise noted, or governed by special contract fixing the rate, minimum charge..... 14.75

2. The rates for EXISTING unmetered water services other than 3/4" (three-quarters of one inch) services are hereby established as follows:

1" Service.....\$21.00

3. In any circumstance in which a residential use is joined with a commercial use in the same premises or upon the same Assessor's parcel, the charge shall be levied for each use at the full rate provide in this Ordinance.

ARTICLE IV. METER RATES

1. Meter Rate Schedule. Rates for all metered water services are hereby established as follows:

(a) Domestic and Commercial:

Minimum Monthly Charge:

3/4	inch meter.....	\$ 14.75
1	inch meter.....	22.30
1-1/2	inch meter.....	33.35
2	inch meter.....	49.00
3	inch meter.....	100.25
4	inch meter.....	144.10

(b) Charges for water delivered to domestic and commercial with credit for minimum charges:

\$0.54 per 100 cu. ft.

(c) Industrial:

Minimum Monthly Charge:

3/4	inch meter.....	\$ 24.90
1	inch meter.....	29.75
1-1/2	inch meter.....	39.00
2	inch meter.....	74.10
3	inch meter.....	151.70
4	inch meter.....	218.20

Any size over two inch (2") must be negotiated with the Board of Directors for availability and meter minimum monthly rate.

(d) Charges for water delivered to industrial with credit for minimum monthly charges:

\$0.54 per 100 cu. ft.

This Ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 1995.

This Ordinance shall be immediately posted at three public places within the district as provided by Public Utility Code, Section 16075.
