# Community Health Assessment (CHA) Overview

A Community Health Assessment (CHA) refers to a state, tribal, local, or territorial health assessment that identifies key health needs and issues through systematic, comprehensive data collection, and analysis.

Necessary components include multisector collaborations, proactive, broad, and diverse community engagement to improve results, maximum transparency to improve community engagement and accountability, and use of evidence-based interventions and encouragement of innovative practices with thorough evaluation.



# Stakeholder Engagement with CHA

#### **CHA Kickoff Meeting**

In June 2022, a CHA kick off introductory meeting was held to provide an overview of the Community Health Improvement Process and ask for stakeholder input on how to effectively engage with the Yuba County Community in this process.

#### **Focus Groups**

10 focus group meetings were held in November 2022 throughout Yuba County for the purpose of engaging the Yuba County community.



# Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP)

The Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) is a **longer term, systematic effort** to address health needs and issues identified through the CHA activities and the community health improvement process.

A CHIP is critical for developing policies and defining actions to target efforts that promote health.

It should define the vision for the health of the community through a collaborative process and should address the gamut strengths, weaknesses, challenges, and opportunities that exist in the community to improve the health status of the community.

#### **CHIP Opening and Closing Meetings**


CHIP kickoff held on March 29, 2023 and closing held on September 13, 2023.

CHIP, action plans, & dashboards published on the Yuba County website. Dashboards will be updated annually for progress tracking.





### Parks and Recreation Workgroup

The formation of a Yuba County Parks and Recreational Workgroup is outlined in Goal 1, Objective 1.1, and Strategy 1.1.1 of the Safe Neighborhoods & Built Environment priority from the CHIP.

The Yuba County Park and Recreational Workgroup is a multi-agency working group of parks and recreation professionals and recreation stakeholders working and/or living in Yuba County. The primary goal, and ultimate desired outcome, is to promote and increase the use of currently available parks and recreation spots across Yuba County by January 30, 2026.
