



General Manager Report of Activities for January/February 2025

February 28, 2025

Building Permits	We have had 19 since the beginning of January.
Sports, Entertainment and Industrial Infrastructure	The environmental review on the grant is complete and we have submitted the financial portion for review. As you all are aware of, we are expected to receive a \$30M grant from the state. YWA is working on the binding funding agreement. We are waiting for word on the EPA grant for about \$20M (one for OPUD and one for Wheatland) and they have been submitted. Additionally, we are working on EDA grants of roughly \$3M to \$5M each.
Fire Dept.	We received the first draft of the Municipal Services Review (MSR) with Yuba LAFCO for fire and are providing comments
Ad-Hoc Committees	Currently we have the following ad-hocs: audit, and South County infrastructure, South County Infrastructure Funding and County liaison.
IRWMP Grants	The steel main project has been started. We are out for bid on the second phase
Water Treatment Plants	Filter addition project at Plumas Lake WTP has been completed.
Parks Master Plan	We have reviewed drafts of the new parks master plan and should have drafts for the Board soon. Consultant is in the final stages of completion. EPS is working on the financial portion
Wastewater and Water Capacity Fee Updates	The Board selected EPS/Jacobs Engineering to complete the study. The study is underway, and we should have a draft soon. We just started the water capacity fee update through EPS.
OPUD Pool	We are working with our partners on funding
Lifts Station 14 Odor Issue	The project has started and is estimated to take roughly 2 months to complete.
Well 31 Failure and Repair	Well 31, one of 2 wells that feed raw water to the Plumas Lake Water Treatment Plant has experienced a casing failure. The Board approved consultation and repair design at the January Board meeting. We are out to bid on this project
